With an average elevation of 6,800 feet, The Golf Club at Bear Dance offers stunning views of the Front Range and surrounding landscape of The Rocky Mountains. Consistently rated as Colorado's best and most challenging public golf course, Bear Dance offers generous tree-lined fairways framed by flashing white sand bunkers, striking water features, and intricate greens.

Format: Two person teams, scramble format (pick your partner) Both players tee off and select best shot off tee, then play individual stroke play until each member of the group has holed out. One low ball will be recorded.

(100% handicap used. Field will be divided into flights based on total handicap of both people and the final size of the field; those w/o a handicap will play as a 0 handicap)

Directions: I-25 North: take exit 174 toward Tomah Rd. Turn right onto Sky View Lane, turn right onto Frontage road, turn left onto Tomah road, turn left onto Bear Dance Drive. At the traffic circle, take the 3rd exit onto Bear Dance Dr. Turn left at Driveway, turn left and then turn right (the destination will be on the right)

I-25 South: Take exit 174 toward Tomah Road, turn left onto Sky View Ln. Turn right onto Frontage road. turn left onto Tomah road, turn left onto Bear Dance Drive. At the traffic circle, take the 3rd exit onto Bear Dance Dr. Turn left at Driveway, turn left and then turn right (the destination will be on the right)
